

SVP STUDENT RESEARCH & TRAVEL AWARDS

COHEN PRIZE

- Target/Scope – **Innovative research projects of any type** that apply to understanding and interpreting the fossil record.
- Eligibility – All graduate student members of SVP (except previous winners).
- Primary Application Materials – Project description (3 pages); statement of award contribution to project success (500 words); 2 letters of support
- Amount – ~\$3000

DAWSON PREDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP GRANT

- Target/Scope – Projects that help **PhD dissertation completion**, testing hypotheses and demonstrating broad significance to vertebrate paleontology and public understanding.
- Eligibility – **PhD candidate** members of SVP.
- Primary Application Materials – Project description (3 pages); budget; applicant CV; 2 letters of support
- Amount – ~\$3000

ESTES MEMORIAL GRANT

- Target/Scope – Graduate student research projects in **non-mammalian** vertebrate paleontology.
- Eligibility – All graduate student members of SVP.
- Primary Application Materials – Project description (3 pages); budget; 1 letter of support
- Amount – ~\$1800

PATTERSON MEMORIAL GRANT

- Target/Scope – Student **field work projects** in vertebrate paleontology.
- Eligibility – Undergraduate and graduate student members of SVP (projects can be co-authored).
- Primary Application Materials – Project description (3000 characters); statement of award contribution to project success (3000 characters); budget
- Amount – ~\$2500

WOOD AWARD

- Target/Scope – Student projects focusing on **collections based study** of fossil material.
- Eligibility – Undergraduate and graduate student members of SVP (**sponsor of work must also be SVP member**)
- Primary Application Materials – Project description (3000 characters); statement of award contribution to project success (3000 characters); list of museums/collections to be visited (750 characters); budget
- Amount – ~\$1500

JACKSON SCHOOL OF GEOSCIENCES TRAVEL GRANT

- Target/Scope – Encourage student participation at annual SVP meeting.
- Eligibility – Student members who are first author on a presentation (except previous winners).
- Primary Application Materials – Abstract title and author information; detailed financial information about funding you have already received for attending the meeting; personal statement detailing how attending the meeting would contribute to your academic program (750 characters)
- Amount – ~\$400-600
